#### **New Hours**

Effective April 30, 2018 the Magic Valley YMCA new facility operational hours will be:

Monday-Thursday 5:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Friday 5:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Saturday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Sunday closed

For pool hours please refer to our schedule.

Childwatch hours will be Monday-Saturday 9:00 am-12:00 pm and Monday-Friday 4:30-7:30 pm.

#### **Childwatch**

Childwatch, an interactive program for children to participate in while their parents work out, will have a monthly charge of:

One child (with family membership): \$16.00 per month.

Two or more children (with family membership): \$22.00 per month.

Daily Drop In fee of \$5.00 per child/per day (if not paying the monthly fee).

We understand that these changes might cause some inconveniences but are necessary in order to navigate through a difficult transition period into a healthy YMCA for the future. Our goal is to create a financially stable organization that can continue to meet the Youth Development, Healthy Living and Social Responsibility needs of the Magic Valley community in the decades to come.
